BAPTISM

In Matthew 28 Jesus says, "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit." In this gift of God's grace, by water and God's Word, God delivers us from sin and death and raises us to new life in Jesus Christ. We are united with all the baptized in the one body of Christ, anointed with the gift of the Holy Spirit, and joined in God's mission for the life of the world! As they bring their children to receive the gift of baptism, parents and guardians are entrusted to live with them among God's faithful people, bring them to the word of God and the holy supper, teach them the Lord's Prayer, the Creed, and the Ten Commandments, place in their hands the holy scriptures, and nurture them in faith and prayer. Baptismal sponsors promise to nurture children in the Christian faith and help them live in the covenant of baptism and in communion with the church. WORSHIP & NURSERY

We love to be all together in worship! Children can be taught to pray, stand and sit with others during worship, listen to music and learn songs, come forward for children's messages, and receive Holy Communion or a blessing. Our sanctuary PrayGround is equipped with pillows, books, fidgets, and coloring materials. Our Baby Zone has a mat and age appropriate soft books and toys. Our nursery is open on Sunday mornings and Wednesday evenings and is staffed by childcare workers from our Early Learning Center and volunteers who have received a background check and taken our safety training. Our children help collect our Noisy Offering on the 2nd Sunday of the month; and on 5th Sundays we invite children, youth and families to take a leadership role in worship!

SUNDAY SCHOOL

Children ages 3 through grade 4 meet on Sundays at 9:30am in classrooms, and join their families in worship during the sharing of the peace.

FAITH MILESTONE MINISTRY

Transfiguration Lutheran Church has a long history of celebrating faith milestones, and we will be reigniting that tradition over the course of the year! We also hope that our 5^{th} - 6^{th} graders will join their families for worship on Sunday mornings and share their gifts and time by greeting, ushering, lighting candles, and reading scripture.

CONFIRMATION

Vision and Goals

Confirmation is a time to uncover the mystery of God's promises and presence in our lives. It is a time to affirm the promises made in baptism and say YES to the God who first said yes to us. Our goal is that every student will:

• Know that faith is a journey lived in a community experiencing fellowship, service, worship, and prayer, while entering into one another's joy and suffering

- Experience scripture as a living example of God's ongoing and faithful promises
- Experience Jesus as a friend and model of a faithful life
- Experience the Holy Spirit as the very real and mysterious presence of God at work in the world
- Think about their gifts and talents and how they can be used to love and serve others

Worship, Learning Experiences, and Expectations

Our Confirmation youth gather from 6:30-8pm on Wednesday nights for pizza, fellowship, games, small groups, service projects, and conversations about the Bible, Luther's Small Catechism, safe and healthy relationships, vocation, spiritual gifts, and important life questions. Friends are welcome! After the first visit, we ask friends to bring back a completed Registration Form and Medical Form if they'd like to continue their participation.

Confirmation is a time for our youth to take responsibility for their own faith journey, and their commitment to participate in a community comes with expectations that will encourage conversation and accountability. We ask our youth to:

- Actively participate in worship on Sunday mornings and Confirmation on Wednesday nights.
- Share their gifts and time in worship by greeting, ushering, lighting candles, and reading scripture. Grow as leaders by signing up to be a Sunday School Teacher Assistant.
- Serve our church and community.

We want you here as often as possible! But we understand that families have commitments outside of this faith community and we want to support you in all aspects of your faith and daily life. We have independent learning options for youth who must be absent for extended periods of time.

Affirmation of Baptism

In 9th grade, our confirmation youth will write a Faith Statement, have a Faith Conversation with Deacon Erica Larson, and experience a special confirmation gathering in preparation for the Confirmation Worship Service. The 2025 service is on Sunday, May 18, 9:30am!
